Status WA 1	Busy summer for WA1, continued work on evaluation framework. Developing the economic evaluation database and links to mature cases.

	TelCo last week, successful meeting of sustainability task force at Oslo last week. Joint WP11&13 workshop planned for 1/2 October in Berlin.

	Confirmed: MS26 due on M21 will be achieved together with other WA1 items in M24.

	WP22: completion of D22.4 (by part 3) will be delayed by two months, but this is not critical, no knock-on effect on other project tasks.Confirmation on D22.5 (after the meeting by e-mail from Rita): will be achieved 3 months late (M23), but no negative impact on other project activities expected.	
	WAMT appreciates the initiative of DHI to offer & prepare a 2-3 days workshop at DHI (early 2016) to inform and train WA3 partners about the software. DHI will be asked to prepare a one-pager about this workshop (scope, target audience, contents, objectives)

	Emscher: going well.	
Status WA 3	Hoffselva: The location selected for the HRF demonstration has not enough water for the UFT cross-lamella settler. Herman Helness will prepare a memo about the issue and potential corrective measures.	
	Westland: going smoothly. Getting a lot of data; during the summer the site owner used only the system installed by DESSIN.	
	Athens: remaining milestone MS24 seems to be achieved.	
	Llobregat: no update available (due to summer break)

Status WA 4	Next issue of newsletter by mid of October. Will include policy briefs and interview and report from a case study. Contents received from a couple of partners. Next issue of annual magazine by end of the year.	
	Demo sites as showcases: Poster for Llobregat is nearly finished; will get final check/polish by the dutch designer of the posters for the TRUST conference. Will be ready by mid October. There is no general guideline for the showcase development but Gerard is talking individually with each demo site. Dutch showcase completed, financially supported by other Dutch initiatives. 2 Weeks ago official opening of the full sites; Gerard in contact with Nadine at Emscher; similar discussions with Christos about Athens. No concrete idea for Hoffselva yet, will be developed later after the issue with the location has been solved.
